

ICC Proposal:

Purpose: To provide organization for the clubs and to make sure clubs are being held accountable for their responsibilities. ICC will maintain a calendar of club events. ICC helps communication, encourages co-sponsorship of events, and provides support and resources for clubs.

Chair: SGA Vice President

Membership: Vice President of every chartered club, unless the Vice President is not able to attend all meetings. If the Vice President cannot sit on ICC then an appointed officer will attend.

Requirements: Each chartered club must attend all meetings. Each club must participate in a community service and campus-wide event each semester.

Each club will report to the ICC chair when and where their events will take place.

If a club fails to meet these requirements, they could potentially lose their charter.

First Offense- The club will receive a warning.

Second Offense- The club must help with an event deemed appropriate by the ICC chair, such as: Homecoming, Catawbapalooza, or the Inaugural Ball.

Third Offense- The club's charter is revoked and the club must start the charter application process over.

Offenses Include: Not attending an ICC meeting, not participating in a community service and campus wide event each semester, not handing in budget requests on time, not attending mandatory budget meetings, and not meeting any other club responsibilities.
