A regularly scheduled Congress Meeting was called to order by President Kendra Joyner on Thursday, October 7, 2010 at 9:00 p.m. in the Student Government Room of the Cannon Student Center. ### **Executive Board Reports:**

- A. President:
  - i. Planning has started on the Christmas Tree Lighting
