Minutes: September 9, 2010

A regularly scheduled Congress Meeting was called to order by President Kendra Joyner on Thursday, September 9, 2010 at 9:00 p.m. in the Student Government Room of the Cannon Student Center. Quorum was present with Cindy Cook absent. The minutes were read silently and were approved with zero corrections.

Executive Board Reports:

- A. President:
 - i. New members were sworn in.
 - ii. The leadership retreat was a great success. Thanks to all who attended.
 - iii. There were two executive meetings since the last Congress. Constitutional inconsistencies and other general SGA changes were the topics of the meetings.
- B. Vice President
 - i. Freshmen elections- two spots are still open
 - ii. Homecoming elections:

 - b. Elections are Sept. 20 and 21
 - c. King and Queen elections are Sept. 23 and 24
 - iii. ICC meeting was August 25th. Clubs were advised of correct procedure for year.
- C. Treasurer
 - i. Three budget requests in so far, for the to-go boxes, Catawba Crazies and the RHA. The budget for RHA was denied.
 - ii. SG AFC now has all of its members.
- D. Secretary
