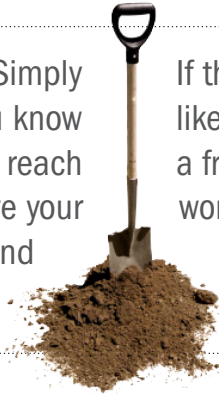
More than 80 percent of all job openings are not advertised to the public.
