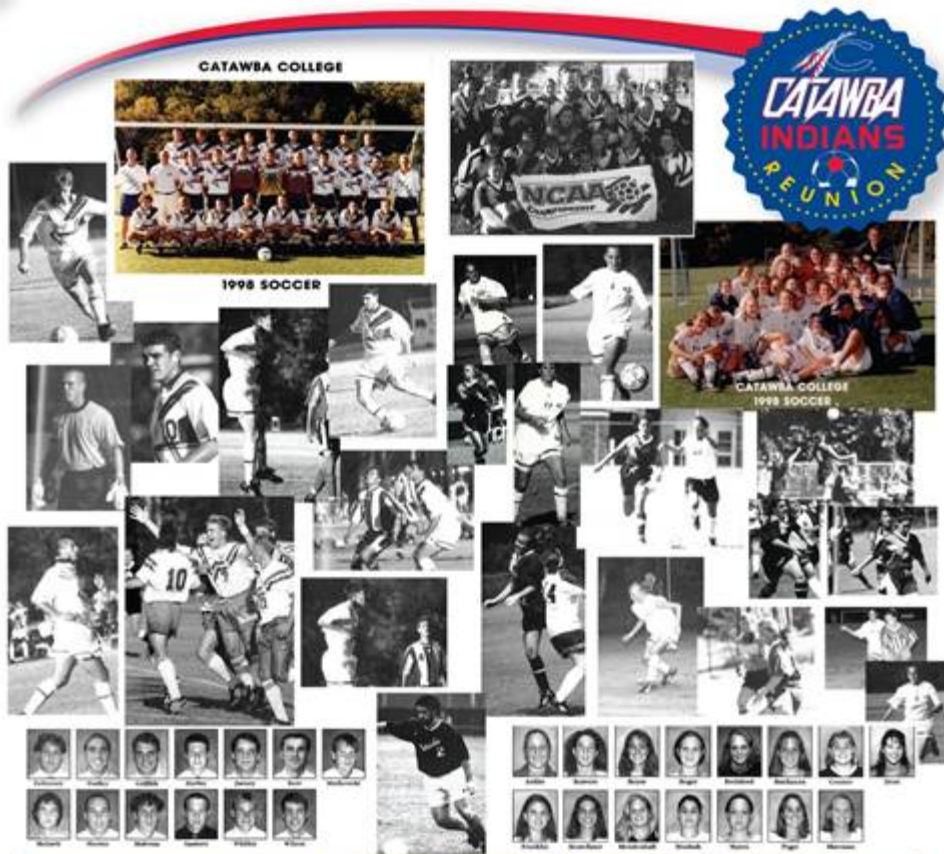

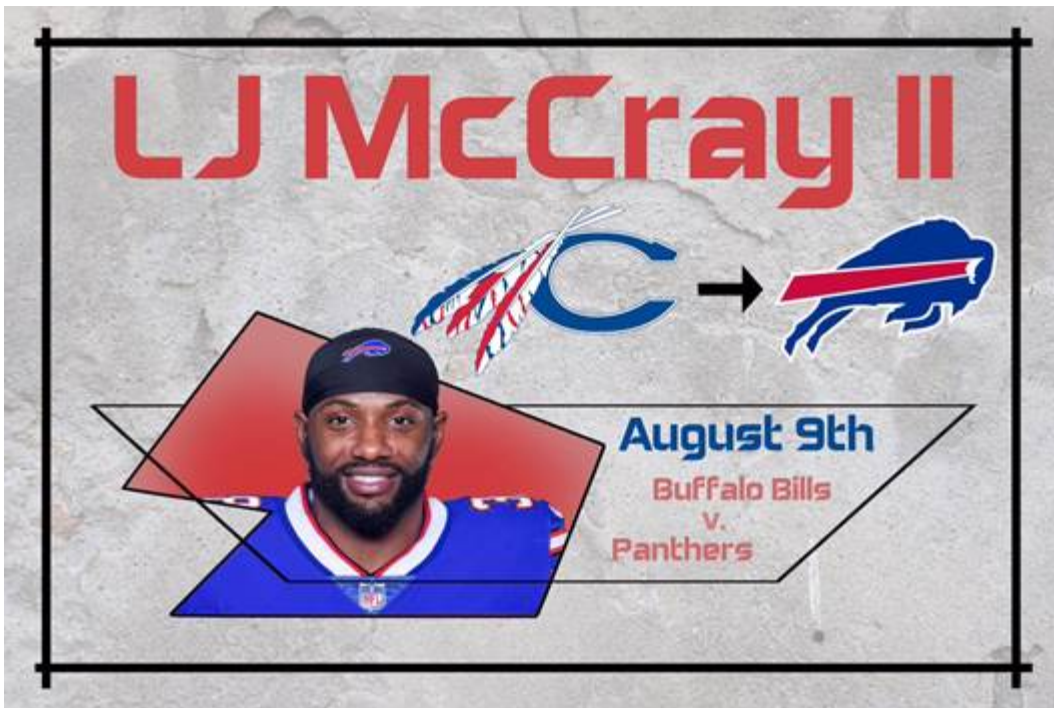

We are about two months away from our 2018 [Catawba 100 Golf Marathon](#). Monday, September 24th at 7:30am at McCanless Golf Course.

We are always looking for new people to play in this special event as well as new sponsors. We rent the golf course for the entire day, and the idea is to play 100 holes of golf in one day, as fast as you can. Each player will have their own cart, and lunch and drinks will be provided.

Anyone can hit a hole in one, but how many of you can say you have played 100 holes of golf in one day?

We raise funds through each player who locates people/businesses willing to sponsor a player for a specific amount for each hole played.
