

ADVANCED PLACEMENT CREDIT POLICY

Students who took Advanced Placement (AP) courses in high school and took final examinations in those courses which were certified by the College Board may request college credit for such courses by having official AP scores sent directly to the Registrar's Office from College Board.

Students receiving a 3, 4, or 5 on the AP Examinations will have an "S" grade recorded for an appropriate course on their permanent records. The course will be shown on the transcript as credit received but will not be used in calculating the grade point average. Examples of credit awarded are as follows:
