

### **Mandatory Testing Plan**

1. All students, faculty (including adjunct instructors), and staff who either teach or are enrolled in a face to face or hybrid class are required to complete COVID-19 testing on campus as set forth below. This testing will be free of charge.
2. Catawba will test students and employees weekly in four (4) categories:
  - a. Front line staff employees in the Proctor Health Center, Public Safety, Maintenance, and Housekeeping Departments and the Catawba nursing faculty;
  - b. A randomized selection of students;
  - c. A randomized selection of employees; and
  - d. Targeted testing of student groups and/or employees. Catawba will identify the targeted groups based on then-current isolation and quarantine data and a schedule of planned events and activities involving Catawba students and employees.
3. Students who fail to test at the appointed time shall have their Catawba ID cards deactivated and may face student conduct charges. Students will reactivate their Catawba ID cards only by providing good and substantial cause for missing their testing appointment, providing proof of vaccination as set forth hereinbelow, providing proof of a positive COVID-19 test within 90 calendar days prior to their scheduled testing appointment, or testing during the following testing appointment window. Student extracurricular activities, including athletics, do not exempt a student from this testing requirement.
4. Catawba will use Abbott BinaxNow rapid antigen tests for all mandatory testing.
5. Persons who received a positive COVID-19 test within 90 calendar days prior to their testing appointment are not required to test. If not previously disclosed to Catawba, students are to provide proof of a positive COVID-19 test to the Proctor Health Center. Employees are to provide proof of a positive COVID-19 test to Human Resources.
6. All student-athletes, coaches, and athletics support staff are required to undergo regular COVID-19 testing in accordance with NCAA, South Atlantic Conference, and Catawba Athletic Department policy. As long as these students, coaches, and staff participate in this mandated testing, they are not subject to on-campus COVID testing. All other students and employees are to be included in this testing regimen. Whether a student-athlete or other athletics support personnel is excluded from this testing requirement shall be determined by the Director of Athletics or his designee.
7. A student who is symptomatic shall notify the Proctor Health Center at 704-637-4404 and will be either tested using a rapid antigen test or directed to obtain a PCR test at an off-campus location.

8. Catawba will conduct drive-through testing outside the Robertson Community Center near Keppel Auditorium, beginning February 16. Persons are to enter only at the designated entry point and follow traffic directions around the Robertson Community Center parking lot. Persons shall remain in their cars for this testing and are not to enter the Robertson Community Center for testing unless otherwise directed. Upon completion of testing, persons are to remain in their vehicles and in the Robertson Community Center parking lot until advised of their test results.
9. Students and employees in quarantine during the testing days and times above shall NOT report to campus for testing. You will be required to entry test upon completion of your quarantine period and prior to being present in any campus building.
10. Students and employees who are fully vaccinated are not required to participate in this testing program. Persons are considered fully vaccinated for COVID-19 if more than fourteen (14) calendar days have passed after receiving their second vaccination dose (if Moderna or Pfizer) or their single vaccination dose (if Janssen/Johnson & Johnson).

Students and employees shall provide proof of vaccination to waive this reentry testing requirement. Students are to provide their documentation to the Proctor Student Health Center, and Employees are to provide their documentation to Human Resources.

11. Catawba will provide random testing of students, faculty, and staff on Tuesdays from 6:45 AM to 2:00 PM.
