Cost of Attendance (COA) is the total Direct Charges and Indirect Charges you might pay to go to Catawba College for the entire academic year. COA includes things like tuition and allowances for books and supplies. Direct Charges, like tuition, are paid directly to the Business Office, where Indirect Charges (books, supplies, etc.) are not.

In order to receive an increase to Cost of Attendance (COA), **a student must prove that their cost to attend school is higher than the amount budgeted by the Financial Aid Office.** Please keep in mind that regular costs of living may not be a cost to attend Catawba College. *For example, a mortgage or rent payment would only be able to be covered in Cost of Attendance if the student only has that expense due to enrolling at Catawba. But if the student has dependent care costs during scheduled class times at Catawba College that could be included in the COA with documentation.*
