Stories are powerful. In her last book, Rachel Held Evans identified one of the reasons stories are so powerful in our lives: we are made in the image of a "Storytelling God." Rachel recently passed away, leaving many friends and followers wrestling with their grief in the wake of her senseless death. But as she illustrated through her life and work, our theme this summer, "Story," has powerful implications for a divided and tense society. We each have a story to tell, but we also all have biases, assumptions, and perspectives that we often take for granted. We can isolate and dismiss others when we label them, but it is harder when we get close enough to hear their story. At Discover: "Story" we will explore tools to share our stories and have opportunities to hear the stories of others, all the while considering how God is calling us to be a part of a Greater Story. This Ultimate Story of grace, redemption, justice, and peace continues on, and we get to play a role and explore what our unique calling within it might be. As Rachel wrote, "Jesus invites us into a story that is bigger than ourselves, bigger than our culture, bigger than even our imaginations, and yet we get to tell the story with scandalous particularity of our particular moment and place in time. We are storytelling creatures because we are fashioned in the image of a storytelling God."

Keep telling the story, friends! I can't wait to see you and hear your stories of life and faith this summer and beyond!


