Your 2025-2026 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) was selected for review in a process called verification. This process is mandated by the US Department of Education, requiring schools to verify the data provided on the FAFSA to ensure its accuracy. We must ask you to confirm the information you reported on your FAFSA. To verify that you provided correct information, we will compare your FAFSA with the information on this worksheet and with any other required document(s). If there are differences, your FAFSA information may need to be corrected. You must complete and sign this worksheet and submit it to the Financial Aid Office.

NOTE: Additional documentation may be requested for clarification.

A. Student's Household Information

- You: the student
- Your spouse: if you are married. Exclude a spouse who has died or is not living in the household because of separation or divorce. Include a spouse who is on active duty in the U.S Armed forces.
- Your and/or your spouse's children: if any, you will provide more than half of their support from July 1, 2025–June 30, 2026, or if the child would be required to provide your information if they were completing a FAFSA for 2025–2026. Include children who meet either of these standards, even if they do not live with you.
- **Other people:** if you will provide more than half of their support and will continue to provide more than half of their support from July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026.

The provided criteria for "dependent children" or "other people" align with the requirement that family size align with whom you can claim as a dependent on a U.S. tax return if you were to file a U.S. tax return at the time of completing any the 2025-2026 FAFSA. As a result, you should not include any unborn children in the family size.

Copies of W-2s or an equivalent document for each source of 2023 employment income.

All copies are to be submitted to the Catawba College Financial Aid Office. Please attach copies to this form.

• If you have lost any W-2's, you may order a <u>Wage and Income Transcript</u> from the IRS to satisfy the requirement. You can obtain this Transcript from the same website that you request a Tax Return Transcript.
